A considerable number of the people of my state have expressed some interest in connection with the effect of radio-active dust that may have blanketed the western section of the United States as a follow-up from the hydrogen bomb tests that have been conducted in the Pacific. I am desirous of having you advise me as to whether or not any of this radio-active dust may have some as far east as the state of South Dakota and if it had or will have any effect upon human, plant, and animal lift of this state.
