1. Because of press holiday, no Japanese papers published this morning. death (Embassy's 703) will be major feature tomorrow.

2. In my judgment it would be extremely helpful if US were to offer immediately to family (widow and three young children) act of grace solatium of one million yen (\$2778) outside eventual compensation settlement.

3. Request immediate authorization make this free will contribution from Department's emergency funds or other appropriate source. Department will recall Embassy has consolidated working fund authorization of \$25,000 from AEC (special allotment number 4AA 1308; appropriation number 194390) which presumably could be validated for this fiscal year. In fact this gesture will obviously be much greater if authorization received in time to catch morning papers 25th.
