PASS TO BUGHER, AEC FROM PEARSON

- 1. Conference proceeding smoothly in mutual confidence and good-will between the delegations. Embassy and Japanese Foreign Office comment approvingly on high spirit of straightforward scientific cooperation. Embassy reports conference has encouraged interest in further scientific liaison between two nations with projects being brought forward on Japanese initiative.
- 2. Salisbury formula for press issuances only and no (repeat no) further amplifications and the close cooperation of entire Japanese delegation successful so far in promoting correct news reporting. Only minor press troubles.
- 3. We are elated at considerable amount of Japanese data and conclusions especially prepared for meeting. November 18 session will be devoted in considerable part to Japanese papers and discussions. Hope to return with much information hitherto unavailable.
- 4. We have been requested by Japanese to meet with Komagata head of AEUPIC and with members of delegation of nuclear scientists going to US meeting scheduled for Saturday. (See EMBTEL 1200).
