Subject	: AEC SUPPORT FOR 1951 TEST	E.Walton	rick:

The Director of Military Application has the responsibility for planning and coordinating the AEC participation in the 1951 weapons test at Eniwetok. In order to support its share of this program, the AEC will be required to supply a limited number of staff and clerical personnel for temporary duty with Joint Task Force THREE. It is likely that personnel requirements will include employees in the areas of security, finance, property and supply, administration, etc. Personnel assignments may initially be on a part-time basis, changing later to full-time, as organization and operations progress.

You may therefore be called upon by the Director of Hilitary Application to assist in this staffing problem. In order to simplify personnel and payrolling procedures, and to avoid organizational conflicts or duplication, personnel will be drawn from existing units for Task Force duty. They will continue to be carried for payroll and ceiling purposes by the Division from which drawn. Budget or coiling readjustments considered necessary under this policy may be requested through normal channels by the Division or office concorned.

It is desired that full cooperation be accorded the Director of Military Application in making available such personnel or services as AEC participation in the 1951 test may necessitate.
