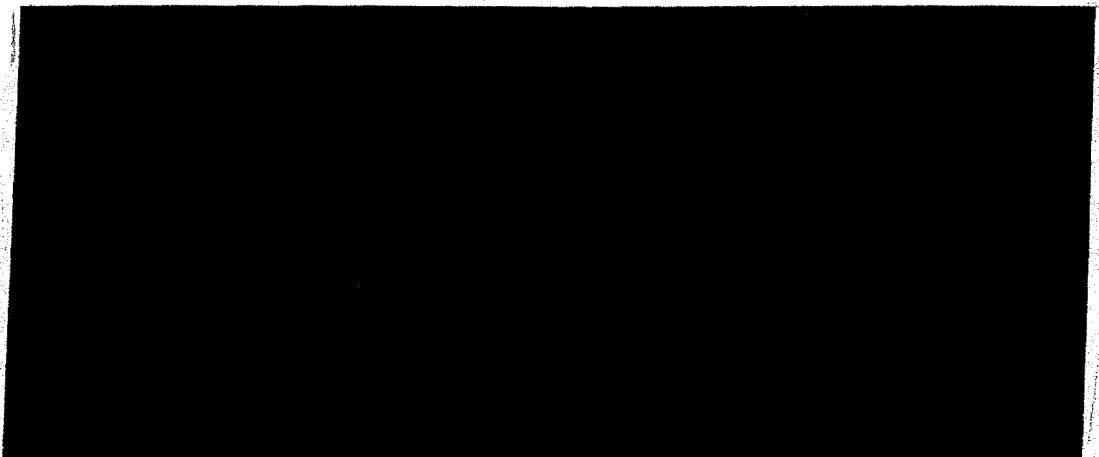

Report by the Director of Military Application

The Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory has informally advised the Division of Military Application that requirements for weapons testing in 1952 will be generally as is indicated below. At this early stage, of course, neither the shots nor the dates can be firmly established; this information is furnished, however, as a guide to the current thinking.
