THE PROBLEM


1. To approve the withdrawal from the stockpile of weapon components for Operation Sandstone.

BACKGROUND

2. Withdrawals from the stockpile are required to meet the approved schedule for Operation Sandstone. Commission authority is required for withdrawals and expenditures of stockpile items.

3. It is considered necessary that the following items be shipped overseas to permit proper conduct of the test:



4. Unexpended components will be returned to the custody of Mr. Carroll L. Tyler on completion of the tests. It is enpected that the returned HE and detonators may be used for surveillance after their storage in the tropics. (See Appendix "5" and its Annex.)

RECOMMENDATIONS

5. That the Atomic Energy Commission:

a. Approve withdrawal from stockpile of the weapon components listed in paragraph 3 and their shipment over-seas under the custody of Captain James S. Russell, USN., with the understanding that unexpended components will be returned, on the completion of the tests, to Mr. Carroll L. Tyler.

b. Note that the General Manager will inform the Manager, Santa Fe Directed Operations, of the above decision by a memorandum such as that in Appendix "A".




