CLEANUP GUIDES AND TIME SCHEDULES FOR KAIWETOK ATOLL REHABILITATION

We intended to provide you with ^{our} comments on T. F. McCraw's memorandum of January 23, 1973, on this subject, by discussion or in writing. I understand that the memorandum is now being recast on the basis of the points brought out in talks between DOS and DMA, and I assume that it will be more profitable for us to look at the new paper.

One modest point which may be appropriate to mention at this time is the distinct identification of organizations who will take various actions. In the memorandum of January 23, the "group" mentioned in paragraph 3, a group with important responsibilities, is not specifically identified. I believe you will agree that both the what and the who need to be stated for the numerous activities with which AEC, DOD, DOI and others will find themselves engaged in accomplishing missions related to Kaiwetok. Although a DOS memorandum on a plan is not the document to assign broad responsibilities, it can appropriately state them and indicate any for which a named division, committee, group and so on has not been specified.
