Dour Mr. LeBarons

To facilitate planning for military participation and support of storic tests, the Corrission wishes to inforz the Coumittee of its current plans for future full-scale wespons test operations. Three separate and distinct series will be discussed in this letter.

IVY

A summary of plans for IVY was forwarded to you by our letter of Cotober 19, 1951, together with a copy of ASC 483/1. Since that time the Commission staff and AEC contractor personnel have continued to work with Joint Tank Force 182 and Armed Forces Epocial Reapons Project toward IVI and have participated in drawing up a mutually acceptable technical program. Three changes in the ori-ginal concept have developed. First, we now plan to everyate all personnel from the Atoll prior to the thermonuclear (MIKE) shot, since the safety of the firing party if left ashure is doubtful. Second, the high-efficiency, high yield (400-600 RT) fission device (AING shot) is scheduled to follow the MIRS shot, conditions following MIRE permitting. Third, unavoidable delays to date in engineering, fabricating, and procuring materials for the cryonomic and other technical apparatus have forced a change in scheduled shot date for MEE from Cotober 1 to Revember 1, 1962.

Consideration has been given to consucting emother fallscale test operation (III) at the Levals Proving Ground following Turking the one ded tentutively planted to cond of UPS Of in the Fall of 1954. It has recently been determined that Wish. I commot be conducted prior to the sarly Epring of 1953. A target date for the baginning of the operation is February 1, 1955. These plans, however, must remain subject to change in the event of unexpected developments. From time to time various Pepartment of Defense agencies concerned with operational problems connected with Pecific Proving Grounds tests have raised informally the question of the approximate date of whatever operation is planned for that area following IVY. Inasmuch as you may wish to bring this matter to the attention of the Joint Chiefe of Staff for necessary support planning purposes, it is our opinion that a date of approximately September-Cotober 1958 represents the best guess that can be made at this time for occupancy of Eniwetok Atoll following IVY. CASTLE is the code name assigned to the series of atomic tests at the Pacific Proving Grounds in the Fall of 1953.
