Lear General Loper:

As requested by Dr. Scoville, attached is a copy of a letter dated December 16, 1952 from Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory, subject "Operational Concept of CASTIX," Symbol J-15163, which is forwarded for purposes of preliminary planning of Weapons Effects Tests.

Your concurrence is requested in the concept that, as in Operation IVI, the military effects tests planned for CASTIE be limited to measurements of the basic phenomena associated with the explosion of very large yield devices. This request is made because of the expense and difficulty in supporting biological experiments and tests involving structures and exposure of military equipment at the Pacific Proving Grounds. It is believed that the adequacy of the latter tests when conducted at the Nevada Proving Grounds and the relative economy resulting therefrom have been clearly demonstrated in the past.
