SUBJECT: ENIWETOK PLUTONIUM STUDIES

CURRENT CONSIDERATION OF CLEANUP OF ENIWETOK HAS POINTED OUT THE PRESENCE OF UNIQUE PLUTONIUM DISTRIBUTIONS ON RUNIT (YVONNE) ISLAND. IF IT APPEARS FEASIBLE THAT THE RUNIT CONTAMINATION COULD BE STUDIED TO OBTAIN USEFUL INFORMATION. DHA WOULD CONSIDER PROPOSING THAT THE AEC LEASE OR OTHERWISE OBTAIN ACCESS TO THAT ISLAND FOR SEVERAL YEARS FOR PLUTONIUM STUDY PURPOSES.

PARA. TOWARD THIS END, IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS BE CONSIDERED ON THE BASIS OF THE BEST RADIOLOGICAL DATA AVAILABLE AND WITH POSSIBLE ASSISTANCE FROM THE PLUTONIUM COMMITTEE TO THE NEVADA APPLIED ECOLOGY GROUP:

- 1. WOULD THERE BE BENEFITS TO STUDYING THE PHYSICAL DISTRIBUTION AND TRANSPORT OF PLUTONIUM IN THE ATOLL ENVIRONMENT AS DIF-FERENTIATED FROM PLUTONIUM IN THE DESERT ENVIRONMENT?
- 2. ARE THERE POSSIBILITIES AT RUNIT FOR USEFUL OBSERVATION OF THE BIOLOGICAL BEHAVIOR OF PLUTONIUM IN THE TERRESTRIAL
