Attached for your information are two letters recently received from Dr. Donaldson regarding his requirements for the summer expedition.

Dr. Donaldson agreed in my conversation with him today to proceed with plans for the expedition timed for his arrival at Majuro on July 24th. It is our understanding that an LCP would be at Pearl Harbor sufficiently in advance to allow for alterations and installation of equipment necessary for this expedition.

Since Dr. Fisher, who will accompany the expedition this year and was also at Majuro last year, is located at the University of Miami arrangements between him and Lt. Commander George P. Greer at Pearl Harbor should work out satisfactorily. It seems desirable, however, to have Lt. Commander Greer return to Seattle to discuss arrangements with Dr. Donaldson in advance, probably, of shipping of equipment to Pearl Harbor. I suggest that the Navy Department through the Naval District in Seattle con time Lt. Commander Greer visit to Seattle at a time convenient to Dr. Donaldson.

Dr. Donaldson indicated that if air-lift was to be provided for equipment to be shipped from Seattle to Pearl Harbor that the lot would amount to approximately 1,200 lbs. The bulk of this material would not be great and he would make every effort to reduce bulk and weight of anything to be shipped.

Dr. Donaldson indicated that if it is not possible to provide an LCP at Majuro they could probably get along with 12 foot dingies but that he felt the LCP's should be available certainly for their work at Majuro.
