During the council meeting after the WBC work all of the questions that we were asked centered around the medical program. As best as I can recall the major questions were:

- 1) When were the Bikinians going to get ID cards like the Rongelap or Utrik people? Response: we don't know if or when they will get cards.
- 2) When do the Bikinians start getting the medical care like the Rongelap or Utrik people? Response: We don't know if you will ever be on a similar program. We do know that the medical team will have sick call once before 1980.
- 3) When do Bikinians get their medication? Response: We don't know if or when this would ever occur.
- 4) Can medical team send general medical supplies? Response: We don't know but will ask.

During the council meeting after the WBC work, all of the questions that we were asked centered around the medical program. Recall as I remember the questions and answers, here is a synopsis of our discussion:

1) When do we need to start like the Rongelap and Ujae people and when are we free to receive medical care?

Response: We don't know if you will receive care or if you will have a medical program like the Rongelap and Ujae people. We will ask Dr. Pratt.

2) When will we be examined like Rongelap and Ujae people?

Response: We don't know when or if you will ever get the examinations given to these other people. We do know that you will receive at least one sickle cell test by your medical team prior to 1980.

3) Will B. cause you any problems for life? Response:

We don't know if or when this would occur.

4) Can medical team send you medical supplies prior to visit? Response: We don't know but will ask.
