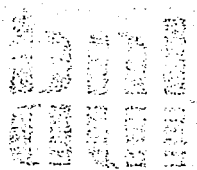

Dear Dr. Nacholz:

The following information is submitted in support of our mid-year request for \$70K in additional operating funds for the BNL Marshall Islands Radiological Safety Program.

The original budget request of \$211K was revised to \$407K during 7Y-1978 to cover anticipated increases in the following areas: (1) personnel monitoring activities; (2) air trips requirements for field trips not supported by the DOE vessel; and (3) weather field trip requests by BRES which could not be anticipated during initial budget projections over a year ago. As a result of the relocation of the Bikinians on 1/17/79, we have had to make two field trips to Rujuro (January and May 1979), which were not a part of our original program plan. No DOE field trip ship support was available for Marshall Islands programs for during 1978. When a vessel became available (early 1979), it could not be used to support the two aforementioned personnel monitoring trips. These trips both involved greater expense to the program than would have been incurred on typical field trips with DOE ship support. The financial burden imposed by these trips is now jeopardizing our planned personnel monitoring field trip to Utirik, Rongelap and Ujelang in August-September. In addition, we discovered in January that the whole body counting trailer was in need of such major repairs as to warrant its replacement. This must be accomplished before the August-September field trip.

At this point, the program is solvent with respect to salaries, overhead, pre-existing commitments and work currently in progress. However, the additional funds are still required to accomplish our late-summer field trip. The estimate was \$50K, but the Laboratory is now imposing its overhead rate on travel and material as well as staff salaries. This brings the total to \$70K.
