MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATIONS - NUCLEAR CLAIMS ISSUES

Enclosed is a copy of the proposed position paper on nuclear claims for Ambassador Rosenblatt to use in his negotiations. It is my understanding that this has gone a long way toward meeting the Department of the Interior's earlier flat objections toward completely ignoring nuclear claims matters. Our input is reflected in the paper in the following ways:

- 1. That medical claims be based on the current legislation.
- 2. That there are provisions for additional legitimate radiation claims.
- 3. That claims for loss of land use due to radioactive contamination are negotiable.
- There is to be right of access to the land and the people.
- 5. There is to be some means of terminating claims based on joint U.S.-Marshallese consultations.

I think the next phase is going to be more an argument over the dollars, which is why they are asking for OMB input. However, I will continue to follow this and keep you informed of developments.
