I first heard that _____ was a child on Lae at the time of Bravo. Then from _____ I heard today that she visited Rongelap in 1956. Today also, though, I saw _____ medical record from Tripler, showing her to be a "30 year old female".

In any event, _____ will undergo thyroid surgery at Tripler tomorrow. The reason that her husband sought me out is that a few years ago _____ mother underwent thyroid surgery (a thyroidectomy, I believe) at Majuro. The coincidental connection, according to _____ account and perception, is that of a family of 9, I believe, _____ and her mother were the only ones who made the Rongelap visit.

_____ has not asked for anything. He simply said to me that he thought this was something we should be interested in. I acquainted him with some of the experience and relationships which you have reported, but suggested that if he wished to pursue the matter further, my first suggestion would be that he have _____ physician in charge communicate with you. _____ will either write you, enclosing the physician's report or have the physician write you direct.

Incidentally, _____ account of the first visit to Tripler has the examining physician say something like:

"Hmm, that doesn't look so good. Where are you from?"

"Oh, yes, the Marshalls. We have had quite a few of these."




