MESSAGE: Per discussion with Major Davis:
The ISSA should be changed to provide for the following services if the need ever arises, at present there are no provisions in the ISSA to cover the following:
The Brookhaven resident doctor does not have referral privileges at the Kwaj hospital. If the doctor wants a patient admitted to the hospital he has to see the T.T. doctor on Ebeye to make the referral. There has been some problems with this procedure in the past. The current ISSA only provides for medical services if the doctor or a member of his family requires medical services.
Also, there are no provisions in the current ISSA for the withdrawal of drugs or narcotics for the Brookhaven doctor. At present, the doctor is able to sign for drugs under the general supplies provision in the ISSA. However, it should be spelled out specifically in the ISSA.
