Two Micronesians Getting A-Tests

TOKYO (AP) — Two Micronesian men, who claim they were exposed to radiation from a U.S. hydrogen bomb test at Bikini Atoll in 1954, have been admitted to the Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Hospital in western Japan for medical checkups and treatment, doctors said.
The two, [redacted] 61, and [redacted] 25, are representatives to a meeting at Nagasaki later this week of the Japan Congress Against Atomic and Hydrogen Bombs.
Doctors said [redacted] claims he

was on Ailingnae Island, some 150 miles from Bikini, at the time of the hydrogen bomb experiment and received burns on his face, hands and legs. [redacted] says, according to the doctors, that his mother, then pregnant, also was on Ailingnae during the test. He complains of tiredness and poor health, doctors said.
