

ELEMENT IS TO PROVIDE AEROMEDICAL SPT TO ITS PARENT SQUADRON. MED
PERS DEPLOYING TO ANOTHER BASE DURING EXERCISE ARE EXPECTED TO
REPORT TO THE LOCAL DBMS UPON ARRIVAL AND ESTABLISH A COOPERATIVE
WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH REGARD TO SPT OF BOTH THE FLYING SE TO
Vehicles ASSD AND OTHER ASSD/ATTACHED BASE PERSONNEL.
