





Subject: Dr. Lauren R. Donaldson's Participation in Operation Greenhouse

Dear Shields:

As you will recall, our original agreement was that Dr. Donaldson would participate in Operation Greenhouse to the extent of a pre-operational survey of the lagoon and a subsequent survey during the operation and that he would be attached to the Bio-Medical Task Unit for operational control during that period.

In order to implement this agreement I requested Dr. George LeRoy to assign Dr. Donaldson a project number and contact him directly to arrange details of the experiment and to provide the support required. Dr. LeRoy has received no communication from Dr. Donaldson since their first meeting in mashington. It is, in my opinion, too late to include this experiment in Operation Greenhouse, particularly since mayal support has been difficult to obtain since the Korean police action.

I regret my inability to obtain the lata for you but assure you that, if I may be of assistance in such an experiment in the future, I will be glad to do what I can.

I would appreciate your advising Dr. Donaldson of this decision.
