It appears that surface and underground shots are potent RF weapons. I think we should make an early attempt to inform FCDA of the facts associated with this use of A-bombs. From what I remember of their "planning" it would be wholly inadequate to cope with a hot spot such as followed the Jangle shots. Since we are obligated to keep FCDA informed of ABC data affecting Civil Defense, I should think that we would be better off to take the initiative, rather than waiting for them to come to us for information.
