Once more we would like to request your cooperation in a monitoring program, this time in connection with the wespons tests planned for this fall in the Pacific. The program will be similar to the one recently completed except that, it will be world-wide in scope.

We would like your Bureau to request from the W. S. Air Force the use of certain of their foreign bases as sampling stations, and then we should like you to administer the program at these bases and your own stations. We are omitting the details from this letter because we have discussed them informally with your representatives and have made tentative arrangements with them, subject to your approval.

During the spring, the meteorologists and observers at your stations have done their part in a faithful and careful manner. We are also grateful to your field men and your headquainters people for suggestions of improvements in method. For these and other reasons, including the fact that your weather station network seems indispensable for a sampling program of the required scope, we want to prolong our valuable association with your erganization in this work.
