It has been noted in the pink reading file that communications relating to future tests have been dispatched from this Division without any classification whatsoever. This is especially true in the case of "Operation IVY."

Your attention is invited to INFO MEMO 317/2 which has been previously circulated by means of the reading file to all Branches.

The one change which should be made when interpreting the instructions of the attached info memo is that the minimum classification for "IVY" should be RESTRICTED--SECURITY INFORMATION. This, as you are aware, is the classification which has superseded the old classification of FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY.

Similarly, all other proposed tests also bear code names which have varying degrees of classification. It is imperative that the instructions regarding classification be adhered to whenever any correspondence concerning weapons tests is developed within the Division.

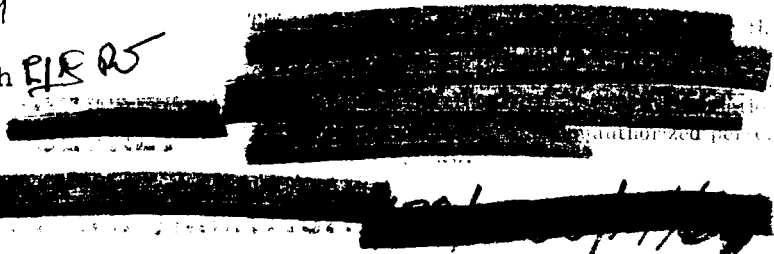
