SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR INFORMATION FROM RAND

In a discussion yesterday with Arnold Kramish, Rand Representative in Washington, he informed us that Merrill Eisenbud recently asked him if Rand could supply certain information relative to Ivy. Kramish has relayed this request to Rand and is advised that estimates can be made on the basis of information received in connection with work that Rand is doing under contract with Los Alamos. If the estimate is to be made for Eisenbud it would appear appropriate for this division to request Los Alamos to permit Rand to use the information involved for this purpose. It appears desirable that on Eisenbud's next trip to Washington that this question be discussed by those concerned, presumably you, Eisenbud, Kramish and perhaps Gordon Dunning. In conversation with Eisenbud yesterday he indicated that he would probably come down next Wednesday and I have told Kramish that this is the most likely date for such a discussion, but that we will notify him when our plans become definite. Mr. Kramish can be reached at Sterling 661h.

I will be glad to tell you these specific questions to which Eisenbud wishes answers if you wish.
