Recent Changes in Snapper Program

. 1. AFSWP has been formally advised that the Navy does not contemplate conducting Projects 2.4 and 4.1.


2. ARDC has advised AFSWP that the Air Force will not conduct Project 2.5.

3. The status of Project 6.7 is at present uncertain. This project, dependent upon the scope of Project 4.1, may be conducted even though Project 4.1 is not. The AEC may conduct a test project similar in scope to that originally contemplated by the Navy in Project 4.1.

4. Project 9.5 originally proposed as part of Project 7.1 will be conducted as a separate project by the Signal Corps.

5. Project 3.2 and 8.2 will not be conducted as they were not approved by the Research and Development Board.

6. Project entitled "Blast Effects on Persistence of Fires (\$30,000) # has been included in Snapper as Project 815.

7. Two additional OCE projects may be included in the SNAPPER program. These will probably be included in Program 1. with the following titles: (a) Effects of Terrain on Blast Effects of Atomic Weapons" and (b) "Ground Shock from Air Blast". The estimated cost for these projects is \$10,000 each.
