Washington, D. C. Result from our resurvey of the Bikini and Eniwetok areas. The program as outlined for Bikini last spring (UAF-1) was completed. The island is intact, no's occupied and sufficient data gathered that it will now be possible for us to evaluate the changes that have taken place to thank the Navy Department on behalf of the Atomic Energy Commission for the splendid cooperation in supporting the "Biological Resurvey of Bikini" and "Survey of Eniwetok".

The ~~work~~ under the guidance of Dr. Warren Donaldson we could work in the field each day. Collections were made in each collecting area with samples of ~~the~~ efforts of Commander Charles B. Marcell, USN, who organized drying. Navy support of the ~~expedition~~ and of Lieutenant J. J. Schmidt, USN, in the capacity of Navy liaison officer, contributed substantially to the successful completion of the expedition's objectives.

The period from July 21 to July 30 was spent at Eniwetok where we collected upon submission of a report to the Commission by Dr. Laurén were in the ~~area~~ Donaldson, we will contact the Navy Department, subject to the ~~area~~ of certain clearance by other interested offices of the sampling ~~area~~ Commission, in connection with a possible joint press release ~~area~~ on the expedition. frozen, dried, and chemically preserved samples for continuing study at our laboratory.
