Japanese are only nationals known to fish on high seas in general vicinity of Northern Marshall Islands. Vessels probably range from 250 to 350 tons and fish for tuna and marlin with buoyed long lines having hooks suspended 100 to 150 feet below surface. Fishery in this area is minor and developed since the war. Seasonal pattern not yet developed but fishing known to have occurred December 1952 and January 1953 between 8 and 10 degrees north latitude and 172 degrees east longitude and 165 west longitude also some scattered activity west of 165 degrees east longitude and between equator and 10 degrees north. Suggest contacting US Embassy Tokyo for fully current information.
