It is requested that your office arrange for the procurement of a 200-milligram standard cobalt 60 source. The source is to be mounted in the standard Oak Ridge container and will be used for calibration of rad-safe instruments at the Pacific Proving Grounds.

This item can be procured from the Carbide & Carbon Chemicals Company, P. O. Box F, Oak Ridge, Tennessee. A Mr. John H. Gillette, an employee of CACC, may be contacted for additional information if necessary. His number is Oak Ridge, LL-220, Ext. 6661.

The cobalt 60 source should be shipped by CACC direct to the National Bureau of Standards for calibration and certification, after which it is to be shipped to the AEC Resident Engineer, APO 187 (ROW), c/o Postmaster, San Francisco, California. All shipments should be made via air freight.

It is our understanding that the 200-milligram cobalt 60 source with standard Oak Ridge container will cost approximately \$100.00, plus \$125.00 for the lead-lined shipping container. In addition to this there will, of course, be costs of shipping and calibration by AEC.
