Enclosed are three copies of a letter and a proposed program from the Oak Ridge National Laboratory covering tentative plans for the subject conference, a continuation of the annual spring symposia sponsored by Dr. Hollaender and appropriate sections in the Biology Division.

We wish to call your attention to three proposed speakers on this program who are not American citizens. These are Mrs. H. Ephrussi-Taylor from Paris, Dr. H. B. Newcombe from Chalk River, and Dr. C. D. Darlington from Hertford, England. Travel expenses for these participants will be paid on the same basis as for the others, i.e. within the continental United States only.

The problems of genetic recombination in relation to radiation appear to us to be worthwhile subjects for such a conference. We will appreciate your review of this proposal and your comments with respect to approval that the conference be planned for April, 1954. No request for additional funds is involved.
