With regard to the request of Dr. Kenneth G. Scott, University of California Medical Center (see copy of letter attached), I regret to advise you that it does not appear as if we will be able to render Dr. Scott any assistance in the solution of his problem. While the amount of priority assistance he has requested is not large, the procedure for establishing a priority rating for the project is extremely difficult and it is the general consensus of opinion that the Commission does not have the authority to allocate its rating privilege to activities beyond its responsibility and sponsorship.

I am sorry to disappoint Dr. Scott in this matter and hope that he will be able to obtain such necessary equipment as he may need without a priority rating.
