HE COULD AND WOULD, I WOULD ATTEMPT TO GET AN IMMEDIATE VISIT APPROVED (NOT WANTING TO ACT UNILATE-RALLY). UNFORTUNATELY, THE SAME SUBJECT HAD BEEN AT ISSUE IN THE COURTS IN HAWAII, WITH DOD SEEKING A PRO-TECTIVE INJUNCTION. THE TERMS OF THE COURT RESOLUTION OF THAT ISSUE MADE OUR VISIT INADVISABLE, AND THE MATTER WAS DROPPED.

WE HAD A CONSTRUCTIVE FRIDAY MEETING WITH BARRY AND BALOS, DEBRUM AND PETE COLEMAN TO HEAR LCDR. BROWN AND EARL GILMORE DESCRIBE THEIR ACTIVITIES AND DIS-ASSOCIATE THEMSELVES FROM PACE. AGAIN I THINK BARRY
