WE MADE IT PERFECTLY CLEAR TO ATTORNEYS MIHO AND REYNOLDS IN THE PRESENCE OF JUDGE KING ON OCTOBER 4 IN HONOLULU THAT THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1969 (NEPA) APPLIES TO ANY AND ALL ASPECTS OF THE ENEWETAK REHABILITATION PROGRAM AND THAT BEFORE MAKING ANY DECISION TO PLAN OR EFFECTUATE IT.
