TALKED AT LENGTH WITH COLEMAN. HE DOES NOT EXPECT TO ADD ANY REPRESENTATION TO OUR FIRST CONTINGENT. HOWEVER WE AGREED THAT IT MIGHT BE HELPFUL TO HAVE WITH US SOME MEMBER OF THE TT STAFF WHO HAD BEEN PRESENT ON OUR MAY VISIT WHEN THE UJELANG LEADERS WERE PRESENT. I AGREED AND COLEMAN INDICATED HE WOULD PROBABLY SEND JOE NAKANISHI FROM THE SAIPAN STAFF AND INVITE DISTAD DEBRUM TO SEND ONE OF HIS PEOPLE. BOTH WOULD COME TO ENIWETOK ON THE REGULAR MAC CHARTER PROBABLY OCTOBER 18TH. I WILL DISCUSS THIS WITH DNA REP. FUTRAL TOMORROW IN TIME FOR HIM TO CALL WASHINGTON IF HE DEEMS THAT NECESSARY. TO US IN WASHINGTON AND TO ME EARLIER AT ENIWETOK THAT IT WAS IMPORTANT THAT QUOTE - THE PEOPLE - UNQUOTE PARTICIPATE ACTIVELY IN REHABILITATION PLANNING. HE FEELS THAT HE HAS A COMMITMENT TO THEM IN THIS REGARD AND I AGREE. HOWEVER I POINTED OUT TO HIM THAT ~~THESE~~ THESE SURVEYS (BOTH OURS AND DOD'S) ARE INFORMATION GATHERING EXPEDITIONS: OURS TO DEVELOP TECHNICAL DATA TO PERMIT JUDGEMENTS TO BE MADE AND DOD'S TO FORM THE BASIS FOR ESTIMATING COST AND TIME FACTORS FOR A CLEANUP. I ASSURED HIM THAT WE WERE NOT ON A REHABILITATION PLANNING EXPEDITION AND THAT HE WOULD BE KEPT INFORMED. I ALSO ASSURED HIM THAT IF IN HIS OR THE HICOM'S JUDGEMENT IT WAS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE TO HAVE NATIVE REPRESENTATION WE WOULD ATTEMPT TO ACCOMMODATE IT. COLEMAN ACCEPTED THIS AND I FEEL CONFIDENT WILL NOT PURSUE IT FURTHER AT THIS TIME.

I TOLD COLEMAN OF THE PRESS RELEASE AND ASSURED HIM THAT I WOULD MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO HAVE IT IN HIS HANDS
