UNCLAS / ROGER RAY SENDS TO C. E. WILLIAMS. TALKED AT LENGTH WITH COLEMAN. HE DOES NOT EXPECT TO ADD ANY REPRESENTATION TO OUR FIRST CONTINGENT. HOWEVER WE AGREED THAT IT MIGHT BE HELPFUL TO HAVE WITH US SOME MEMBER OF THE TT STAFF WHO HAD BEEN PRESENT ON OUR MAY VISIT WHEN THE UJELANG LEADERS WERE PRESENT. I AGREED AND COLEMAN INDICATED HE WOULD PROBABLY SEND JOE NAKANISHI FROM THE SAIPAN STAFF AND INVITE DISTAD DEBRUM TO SEND ONE OF HIS PEOPLE. BOTH WOULD COME TO ENIWETOK ON THE REGULAR MAC CHARTER PROBABLY OCTOBER 18TH. I WILL DISCUSS THIS WITH DNA REP. FUTRAL TOMORROW IN TIME FOR HIM TO CALL WASHINGTON IF HE DEEMS THAT NECESSARY. AS TO THE NATIVE MARSHALLESE, COLEMAN HAD INDICATED

THAT IT WAS IMPORTANT THAT QUOTE - THE PEOPLE - UN-
