As we have discussed, Dr. Guy S. Haywood has offered to volunteer his services to train the Trust Territory Health Aid at Bikini Atoll during the latter part of June, 1975. To facilitate this activity, NE has arranged for Dr. Haywood to accompany the ERDA radiological survey party aboard the Marshall Islands Research Vessel. This radiological survey is currently scheduled for an approximate two week period commencing about June 12, 1975.

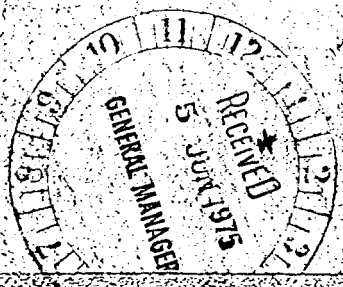
Because by accompanying the government/contractor survey team Dr. Haywood will be placed in a position such that he might provide medical care incidentally or in a medical emergency involving a survey team member, we desire to provide him liability insurance coverage, including malpractice coverage, during the period of his association with ERDA.

It is our understanding that you have discussed this matter with American International Underwriters, Inc., who are the underwriters of your liability insurance coverage in the Pacific area under Contract AT(29-2)-20, and that they have agreed to extend coverage to Dr. Haywood upon your written request.

Please accept this letter as your authorization to enter into an appropriate service contract or other agreement with Dr. Haywood, and to provide him with liability insurance coverage.
