Dear Bills

We need an official radio-active safety evaluation of the suitability of the ground water on Bikini for human consumption. We also need a check for bacterial contamination.

We feel that we should have more than one sample from one location, before we can state without reservation that the ground water on Eneu and Bikini Islands is safe for human consumption.

As you know, the water samples which were sent to the Honolulu AEC office for analysis over two months ago, arrived there at the wrong temperature. It was therefore impossible to make a meaningful analysis.

Can your office help us by furnishing the necessary information and instructions involved in gathering and shipping water samples?

We feel that the official evaluation should be done before the people on Bikini use any of the ground water.

I sure that he question of safety of the ground water will be brought up by the pikt if people and perhaps outsiders. We should all be prepared to answer that important questica inequivocally.

A secial ship will be leaving to Bikini soon. It would be possible to bring water samples back to Kwasilein on the return trip.

Your assistance will be greatly appreciated.

SAMPLING PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTING GROUND WATER SAMPLES FOR RADIO-ACTIVE SAFETY EVALUATION.

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- I. The sample containers supplied are to be used. Each sample shall consist of approximately one gallon of water which is the volume of each sample container.
- II. One sample should be taken from each source of ground water on ENEU and the other Bikini islands.
- III. The funnel and container used to transfer the ground water to the sample container shall be rinsed with the distilled water supplied before each sample is taken.

IV. Mark each container with the sample location and date of collection. Ru-adduced -- Labels are pre-attached to each container.

I Return samples as soon as possible after collection.

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
