SUBJECT: Status Report, Cleamip of Bikini Atoli (U)

- 2. Reference a requested the Department of the Interior to develop a program to resettle the former natives of Bikini who desire to do so in their traditional home, and references b and c requested the Department of Defense (DOD) and Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) to work with the Department of Interior and the Righ Commissioner of the Trust Territory, Pacific, as nacessary to assist in accomplishing the resottlement. The DOD and the AEC agreed jointly to undertake to clear Bikini Atoll of residuals from its test use which could be hazardous

to the natives or interfere with their agricultural use of the land, as a prerequisite to resettlement, and references d and e designated Director, Defense Atomic Support Agency (DASA) as the DOD and AEC Project Manager for this operation. Funding in amounts of \$300,000 each from AEC and DOD were provided to support cleanup operations commencing in FY 1969, with \$700,000 to be provided by the Department of Interior in FY 1970 to complete this task.

- 3. A combined military and civilian-contractor Tesk Group under Commander, Joint Took Force EIChT (JTP-8), DASA, comprising 23 men with equipment, landed on the Atoll by ship on 18 February 1969 and began the cleanup operation. By 23 February an air strip was operational and certified for Eilitary Airlift Command flight operations.
- 4. The Bikini Tesk Group currently comprises a total of 40, of whom 17 are military. The work is proceeding satisfactorily. As of now it is approximately 20% complete, which is sufficient to afford a realistic appraisal and definition of the overall task. No significant operational difficulties have been experienced and none are forecast. A detailed listing of known cleamy items, with planned disposition, is being prepared as a basis for inter-agency concurrence on the completion of the ADC-DOD tasks. Present estimate is that the latter can be completed by October 1969 if the necessary additional funds in the amount of \$700,000 are available by 1 July 1909.
