Dear Dr. LeRoy:

This will acknowledge your letter of November 4 outlining the sequence of events regarding Dr. Donaldson's participation in the Greenhouse program. I am cognizant of the fact that this has not been appropriately handled and to expedite including Donaldson's absence of the program.

We have a real interest in having Donaldson included in the program and provided such can be done at this late date without seriously handicapping the operations, we feel that such an effort will be justified. It is our recommendation that Donaldson's operations be restricted to three individuals including Dr. Donaldson. It would be quite satisfactory for us if it would aid you for Dr. Donaldson to be counted as one of the observers for the Division of Biology and Medicine. It occurs to me that you may still wish to use Dr. Donaldson as the naturalist referred to in paragraph 6 of your letter of February 11.

I am enclosing for your consideration a copy of the plan of Donaldson's activities and his operational requirements. It is recognized that he would have to use the facilities of the boat pool for transportation and that his needs would be secondary to those of the other phases of the biomedical program.

Provided you can accommodate Dr. Donaldson and the two other individuals that he may select, I would suggest that you advise him directly regarding this participation in Greenhouse Operations.
