Item IV - 10 - P.X., Barber Shops & P. O. Bldg. No. 22. Operational equipment was estimated to include office furniture and machines in the P. X.; barber chairs, customer chairs, and mirrors in the barber shops; and furniture and fabricated letter drops in the post office, all similar to the Perry installation.

Item IV - 11 - Communications and Radio Bldg. Operational equipment was estimated to include furniture and special communications and radio equipment for repair and processing as well as operation.

Item IV - 12 - Latrines. Operational equipment is listed in detail in the current cost estimate submitted on January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 13 - Warehouses. Operational equipment is listed in detail in the current cost estimate submitted on January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 14 - Shop Buildings. Operational equipment was estimated to include heavy shop machinery as lathes, braces, pipe threading machines, and other similar shop equipment.

Item IV - 15 - Four-man Tents. Operational equipment for this item is listed in detail on the current cost estimate submitted on January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 16 - Eight-man Tents. Operational equipment for this item is listed in detail on the current cost estimate submitted on January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 17 - Movie and Recreation Area. Operational equipment was estimated to include projection equipment and furniture, plus athletic equipment.

Item IV - 18 - Sewer Facilities. The operational equipment is listed in detail on the current cost estimate submitted January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 19 - Electrical Distribution. The operational equipment is listed in detail on the current cost estimate submitted January 9, 1953.

Item IV - 20 - Telephone Distribution. The operational equipment is listed in detail on the current cost estimate submitted January 9, 1953.
