SUBJECT: SCOPE OF WORK; BIKINI ATOLL - CONTRACT AT-(29-2)20

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to my letter, MC-162, of the same subject, dated 24 September 1952, and in particular to paragraph 3 wherein you were authorized to construct a 250-man temporary camp on Enimman Island, with planning and layout based on possible ultimate expansion to a 1000-man camp.

In the interests of utilizing presently available manpower to the best interests of the Government until the time when additional construction requirements are forthcoming, you are authorized to proceed with rough-in plumbing and pouring of concrete floor slabs for the nine 100-man latrines and the pouring of additional tent slabs sufficient for an expansion of the camp from 250 to 500 men. As construction and support requirements increase, frames and tents may be erected on these additional slabs as needed.

The above authorization includes the installation of all underground water, sewer and electrical systems as appropriate for the latrines and tents.
