Subject: DECONTAMINATION OF AREA ON SITE JANET

Bear Sir:

It is desired at this time that an area on Site Janet be decontaminated so that a 75' photo tower may be erected at this Site. This area to be decontaminated is to be located adjacent to URRENHOUSE Station 769 and is to be large enough that people and vehicles may operate around the base of this tower. Exact location of this area is to be decided in the field so that an area requiring a minimum of effort may be chosen. This office is to be informed of the coordinates of this location as soon as it is decided upon.

It is suggested that the background reading of this area be brought down at this time to a reading of about 10/mr hr so that within a few months personnel may work a normal week at this location.
