The following ambiguous conditions have been noted on Home Office Site Plans:

DWG. 2201-OB-1, Rev. 5 Site Peter.

1. Station 232.07 appears on the drawing in two places. Once at cood's: N 101,950; EL23,179.46, and once at cood's: N 100,800; EL21,800. Please clarify.
2. Revision Four calls for a change in the cood's of Stations 120.06-120.11, 130.01, 130.03, and 170.01. No change was made in the cood's of these stations on either revision Four or Five. Are these cood's correct?
3. The distance to ground zero for station 102, Oboe should be 16,661.11 feet, according to HN 8710. Suggest correction to DWG.

DWG. 2250-J-17. Site Janet.

4. Station 231.07 will not develop the given cood's using the given azimuth and distance.

DWG. 2249-P-17 Rev. 2. Site Pearl.

5. Station 232.15 will not develop the given cood's using the given azimuth and distance. The azimuth appears to be an error.

DWG. 2227-DO-17 Rev. 1. Site Dog.

6. Note 2 states that stations 1403.07 - 1403.10 should have a clear line of sight to stations 10 and 30. Are these stations to be oriented to a point half way between stations 10 and 30?

Request clarification as soon as conveniently possible.
