Calculations have been made and forwarded to the users of the time required for closing of the automatic shutter ports on Stations 1341 and 1342. In acknowledging receipt of this information, LASL noted that, because of many indeterminate factors involved, calculations of this sort must be used with extreme caution. It was requested that an actual field drop test be made as soon as possible, after shutter is placed in station.

Please make the necessary arrangements for this test, coordinating requirements with Mr. Robert H. Campbell or his representative at jobsite. A detailed report should be made to this office for transmittal to those user agencies concerned.
