Dear Sir:

Per our Mr. R. A. Boettcher's telephone conversation with Mr. Robert Newman of LASL on 10/14/53 concerning screen rooms and the methods of adopting screen rooms to user furnished motor-generator sets at Station 1210, Dog, certain additional information is required.

Mr. Newman requested that our drawings 3303-DO-3 (Station 1210, 1211 and 1212 - Dog - Electrical Power & Grounding Plan) and 3413-Q-3 (Typical Screen Room Details) be revised to show this user furnished motor-generator and screen room connection. From previous correspondence it is our understanding that the user is furnishing three (3) motor-generator sets with control equipment. The sets are of the fly-wheel type, with a 208 volt, 3 phase, 60 cycle, 30 H.P. motor driving a 20 KW generator. The equipment is manufactured by the Electric Machinery Corporation.

The method of installation for these machines has never been clearly shown on our drawing due to a lack of information. By copy of this letter, it is requested that Mr. Newman furnish us with a complete set of shop drawings on these motor-generator units and all control equipment furnished by the user, so that we may comply with his request.
