Completion Estimate Analysis dated April 14, 1955, of this feature submitted to the Home Office appears to be within the variance limit of 10%, however, the charge of materials for this type of work was questioned. A check of the Warehouse Purchase slips shows that \$1,768.37 was, Moses, Diesel Fuel, Oils and Lubricants. That \$37.02 was repair parts.

This feature had no Direct Charges at originally, as the work was done under E.W.O. 3001, Beach lead, so that all charges lodged against Item A-4 at this time were transferred from the Beach Head account. A cursory study of Sub-Account 100 jobs in the area revealed that:

1. The Causeway, Sub-Account 100, reported 100% complete had only £216.82 Direct labour costs.
2. The L.S.T. Landing Ramp, Sub-Account 100, reported 95% complete, had no costs.

It is felt that a field analysis and study of costs in all clearing and grading accounts at Site Tare should be prior to preparation of completion estimates.
