MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

Recent developments on electric power for the scientific program, as evidenced in correspondence regarding the power plants at Ursula, Nan, Charlie and Tare as well as your AME-100, indicate a possibility that this program may not require all five of the 75 KW Caterpillar-Palmer units now at Jobsite. You will recall that we were instructed some months ago not to use these units for camp purposes because they had been purchased specifically to protect possible scientific requirements.

Upon completion of the fare camp expansion, there will be no spare 75 KW generators available for emergency use or for use as replacements. Unless two or more of the five Caterpillar-Palmer units can now be released, it will be necessary to purchase additional similar units for stock.

It is requested that you review the current status of these machines in the scientific program and advise regarding their release.
