RE: Additional Hospital Space - Site Tare
Mr. Spain in consideration before his departure authorized eight additional beds on site. He has written new thinking in regards that jobsite, the Bellwood, please furnish him with specifications.

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1. Plans submitted for both hospital and dispensary.
2. Whatever the final plan, because of increased personnel at the site, the present storage facilities which are totally inadequate and, therefore, the new structure must accommodate them.
3. Whether joined or adjacent to the present dispensary, toilet facilities will be necessary because of the size of the building. A minimum of a utility pit and no male and female provided and additional toilet facilities would be welcome.
4. Scuttlebutt will be re-evaluated.
5. Eight new hospital beds will be required, complete with mattresses.
6. Building will be completely surrounded in fluey floors.
7. Shutters attached to exterior portion of the wooden shoppes.
8. Concrete floor of the dispensary area of the same should be increased to a 6' x 10' approx.
9. A building attached to the main hospital probably preferable, but depends on available space.
10. One either provide addition to the present building, and start afresh with your originally intended hospital and dispensary, and re-locate to a more convenient location, which would be a reasonable result of the present building.
