Subject: Survey of Buried Copper Pipes at Sally - Ruby Site

In order to best utilize the existing causeway between Ruby and Sally for the erection of the "Alice" pipeline, and to do this without running into interference from buried copper pipes left over from the Greenhouse tests, Holmes and Narver should be directed to conduct the following survey:

1. Trench at right angles to the causeway at each end to determine the depth and location of each pipe, and/or groups of pipes.
2. Trench at two or more intermediate points to assure that the pipes are laid in straight lines.
3. Furnish a detailed map of the causeway showing sections, locations of the pipes, washouts, and how the causeway lies with respect to the existing blockhouse.

The exact location of the detector station cannot be determined until this survey is complete.
