DETAILED DESCRIPTION: This station is located approximately 60 feet from the high tide line on the ocean shore one-half foot west of the easterly end of the island.

The station mark is a capped $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe, stamped "HON" and "Rumoru", set in concrete 6" below the surface.

The reference marks are 2" steel caps, stamped "50' R.P." and "100' R.P." respectively and "Rumoru" and an arrow pointing to Rumoru, set in concrete 10" below grade.
