MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF, ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION

SUBJECT: Increase in Allowance of Fissionable Material
for Expenditure in Operation UPSECT-SNOWHOLE

REFERENCE: Memo for Secretaries of State and Defense from
Executive Secretary, NSC, same subject, dated
May 19, 1953

The Acting Secretary of State and the Secretary
of Defense have concurred in the recommendation contained in
the last paragraph of the enclosure to the reference memo-
randum. The Secretary of Defense, in concurring, commented:

"I note that the Atomic Energy Commission
feels that this action will probably
obviate the necessity for Operation SNOWHOLE
in the fall of 1953 as now planned. This
has been the primary factor in my support
of the proposal."

Accordingly, the above mentioned recommendation was submitted
to the President for his consideration.

The President has this date approved the increased
expenditure of fissionable material and the conduct of the test
as recommended in the enclosure to the reference memorandum. The
President in approving, however, stated that he thought that the
responsible officials should have brought this query up for con-
sideration at a much earlier date.
