Dear Mr. President:

This is to report that the Atomic Energy Commission has reviewed the documentary report film covering Operation IVI and has deleted from it the more highly sensitive portions, in conformity with your recent instructions to me. The resulting film retains a classification of Secret - Restricted Data, and with the deletions we have made, we believe the picture is now suitable for showing to responsible persons who have a need to know the general story of our progress toward the development of a very high-yield weapon but who do not need to know the details of that weapon's construction or operation.

Though some portions of the revised film are still highly classified information, searching review of the presentation has convinced us that the sensitive matter pertaining to weapon design details has been removed. This film is now available here for showing to any groups you may direct to see it. We feel that it should be shown as soon as possible to the Joint Congressional Committee on Atomic Energy, and unless you have objection, we will make arrangements to do so.
